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Reservoir Engineering. The challenge in reservoir engineering is to describe and predict simultaneous flow of one, two, or three fluid phases (oil, gas, and water) through the irregular pore channel network constituting the permeable reservoir rock. It is important to plan the production strategy and well placements to optimize hydrocarbon recovery and predict future performance.
